**Please note the following important information:**

1. New applications for registration must comply with the International Code of Nomenclature for Cultivated Plants (ICNCP) regulations. If not, they are rejected.
2. Only a completely and correctly filled out form can be processed.
3. There is no claim for inclusion in the list.  
The application should be accompanied by at least **two photos** (preferably one close-up of the flower, one of the entire cultivar). The registrant allows the authors of The International *Schlumbergera* and *Rhipsalidopsis* List of Species and Hybrids to publish these photos in the context of the *Rhipsalidopsis* list, in whatever form.
4. The applicant warrants that he is entitled to register the cultivar and that it is not a cultivar already known or already registered in the list.
5. If the registrant is not the hybridizer, he confirms to have the allowance of hybridizer to register the cultivar.
6. All sizes are in centimeters.
7. The new cultivar should have at least flowered for the third year, before registering.
8. The registration in this registry does not imply the creation of Plant Breeder's Rights, patents or other rights to a name (principles 5 and 6 ICNCP).

## Explanations:

### 1. The types are defined as followed:

**R** - Rosea Type, phylloclades flattened, 4 cm long and 2 cm wide, apical and marginal with fine, brown bristles. Flowers broadly funnel form, radially symmetrical, up to 4 cm long, pinkish, self-fertile. Fruits flattened spherical, yellowish, ribbed.

**G** - Gaertneri Type, phylloclades flattened, 7 cm long and 2.5 cm wide, apical with brownish bristles. Flowers broadly funnel form, radially symmetrical, up to 5 cm long, scarlet, self-fertile. Fruits flattened spherical, reddish, ribbed

**GA** - Graeseri Type, the name *R. × graeseri* applies to crosses in both directions, i.e. no matter, which plant is mother plant or pollen dispenser. Phylloclades and flowers are an average between *R. rosea* and *R. gaertneri* in many colors. For commercial breeders this is the main type.

**GR** - *R. × graeseri*, but with mainly *R. rosea* traits, flowers though in many colors.

**GG** - *R. × graeseri*, but with mainly *R. gaertneri* traits, flowers though in many colors.

### 2. Hybridizer

Hybridizer is the person who pollinated the plants. If this field is left blank, it is assumed the registrant is also the hybridizer.

### 3. Grower

Grower is the person who grew the plants from seeds. If this field is left blank, it is assumed the registrant is also the grower.

### 4. Distributor

The complete name of the distributor must be given. The distributor is the person or firm who brought the cultivar into commerce, or offered the plant to others for distribution. If this field is left blank, it is assumed the registrant is also the distributor.

### 5. Name giver

The name giver is the person who derived the cultivar name being registered. If this field is left blank, it is assumed the registrant is also the name giver.

### 6. Hybridizer's reference means a number or code of the hybridizer to identify the plant.
